Promised benefits of self-organization Freedom of expression - anonymity Freedom of association - finding, "meeting" those with similar treedom of information (news/media, social ...) - to learn interests (together) 2 Resistance to central control, censorship Inclusiveness: everyone should have a voice I role Fairness, equality: everyone has equal "voice" or "paner" Recognition, opproval by peers-peer review Structuring, curating information collectively

Applications for self-organizing technologies Keep up on local/global goings-on" Sharing information & knowledge, learning Deliberation, decision-making on policy (incl. remotely), Science - Formal peer review as "publication gateway" Culture-enabling artists to emerge, get recognition, economic support/reward Entertainment (tiktok, Youtube, ...?) Mutual support - emotional, experiences, ... Business/econonic/finance organization - Bitcoin, Ethereum, DAOs

Challenges

Privacy vs information extraction-surveillance capitalism

Echo chambers— hear from your "friends"-already like-minded, narrow "information diet"

Manipulation of public opinion—often toward extreme/radical content
Algorithmic manipulation—algorithmic bias

Information addiction—more excludes, more all revenue

Abuse of anonymity—less subject to social norms/restrains > trolling, attacks
