Randomness in Social process - selection by sortition - Random selection of 'authority' roles - e.g., judges
- Athenian democracy: selection of magistrates - Venetian democracy: selection of doge 1268-1797 why? - utilizing community wisdom, who best to rule - anti-corruption, anti-factionalism-diversity, manipulation why iterative? we don't know but...
- Trial by jury non-manipulability, non-expert - Public opinion polling; focus groups - diversity, representative

- Deliberative polling: explore more deeply

Benofits: participant = collective: better more reasoned/diverse into

cilledive = participant: make better citizens, consensus
