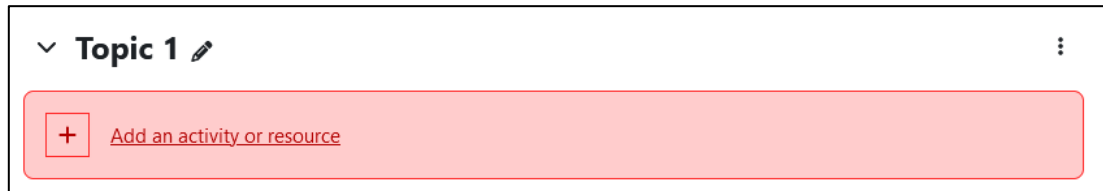


How to add an assignment (file submission)?

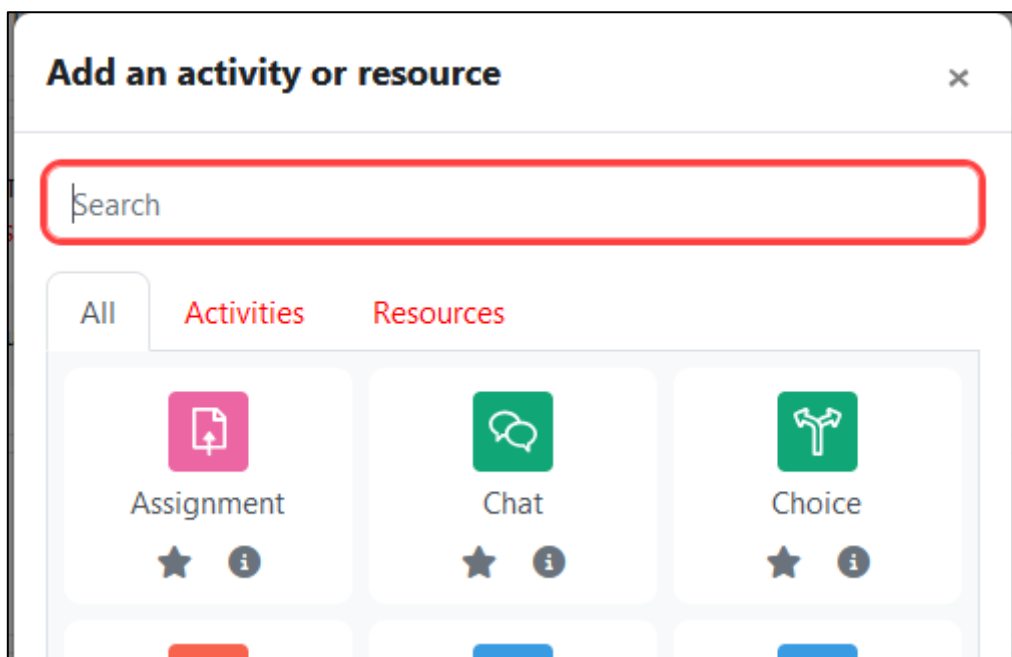
→ Start by toggling “Edit mode” on:



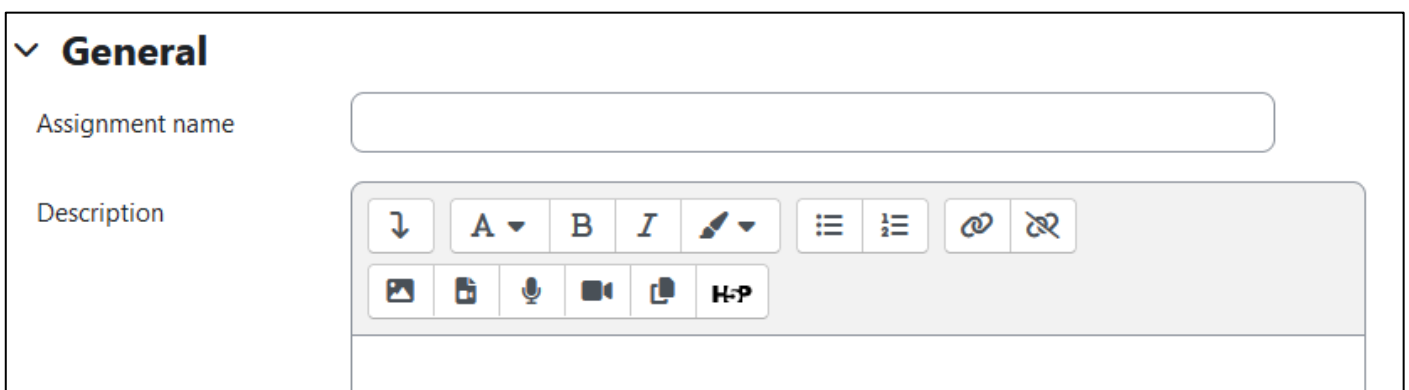
→ Then go to the section of your course that you wish to add the group selection choice to, and click on “Add an activity or resource”:



→ Pick “Assignment”:



→ Add an assignment name and a description, as well as any other relevant information in “General”:



- Under “Availability”, set submission dates: “allow submissions from”, “due date” and a “cut-off date” (if no cut-off date is enabled, students will still be able to submit after the due date, but submissions will be marked as late).
If you don’t want to allow late submissions, set “cut-off date” and “due date” the same:

Availability

Allow submissions from Enable 17 September 2023 00 00 📅

Due date Enable 24 September 2023 00 00 📅

Cut-off date Enable 17 September 2023 23 00 📅

Remind me to grade by Enable 1 October 2023 00 00 📅

- For file submissions, under “Submission type”, check the “file submissions” box:
